
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 373, L.D. 1232, Bill, "An Act to Provide Relief from Barking Dogs"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§3912-B." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "The owner or keeper of a dog that" and inserting in its place the following: 'When a dog'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§3912-B." in the first paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "yelping" the following: ', the owner or keeper of that dog'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that when a dog repeatedly disturbs people by prolonged, repeated or habitual barking, whining, crying, howling or yelping the owner or keeper of that dog commits a civil violation.
