An Act to Require Reflectors on Ice Fishing Shacks.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6523, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is amended to read:

#### §6523. Marking ice fishing shacks

It shall—be is unlawful to place any shack or temporary structure used for ice fishing on the frozen coastal waters or to use the shack or structure, unless the owner's name and address are painted or otherwise clearly marked on the outside with 2-inch letters and, except for a rental ice fishing shack, a reflector or reflecting tape is affixed to each side of the shack at least 3 feet above the ice. For the purpose of this section, the term "rental ice fishing shack" means an ice fishing shack equipped with electric power and owned by a person engaged in the business of renting ice fishing shacks. The fine or penalty for conviction of violating this section shall—include includes the costs incurred in removing any structure.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7628, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

#### §7628. Failing to label ice fishing shack

A person is guilty of failing to label an ice fishing shack if he that person owns any shack or temporary structure used for ice fishing, and he fails, when the shack is on the ice of any inland water, to have painted on the outside of the shack or structure in 2-inch letters the owner's name and address when-the shack-or-structure-is-on-the-ice-of-any-inland-waters or, except for a rental ice fishing shack, fails to affix a reflector or reflecting tape to each side of the shack at least 3 feet above the ice. For the purpose of this section, the term "rental ice fishing shack" means an ice fishing shack equipped with electric power and owned by a person engaged in the business of renting ice fishing shacks.

### 40 SUMMARY

This bill requires ice fishing shacks on inland and coastal waters to have reflectors or reflecting tape affixed to each side of the shack at least 3 feet above the ice. Rental ice fishing shacks equipped with electricity are exempt from this requirement.
