Resolved: That the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall prepare a plan to 2 phase out the Maine State Retirement System, referred to in this 4 resolve as the "retirement system." 6 Required provisions. The plan must contain at least the following provisions. 8 plan must provide for the The establishment individual retirement accounts for state employees, teachers 10 and employees of participating local districts. 12 В. The plan must be developed in consultation with a 14 representative of the retirement system, representatives of retired members of the retirement system, representatives of collective bargaining agents representing covered employees 16 and representatives of participating local districts. 18 The plan must consider the income tax implications for members of the retirement system. 20 22 The plan must permit employees leaving covered services to roll over their retirement accounts without penalty into 24 other pension systems, individual retirement accounts or other accounts subject to federal income tax deferral. 26 The plan must provide for gradually phasing out the 28 retirement system and transition provisions to ensure the protection of persons currently receiving retirement 30 benefits and those who are currently members retirement system. 32 The plan must provide that the State make contributions to an employee's individual retirement account that equal 34 the contributions made by the employee; and be it further 36 Sec. 2. Submission of plan. Resolved: That the commissioner 38 shall submit the plan to the 118th Legislature by January 1, 1998.

This resolve requires the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services to prepare a plan for the gradual phaseout of the Maine State Retirement System and its replacement with a system of individual retirement accounts that would be completely portable and would require the State to match the employee's contribution to the account.
