COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 918, L.D. 1261, Bill, "An Act Concerning Public Notice of Lottery Odds"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§1, ¶M is enacted to read:

M. The imprinting on all lottery tickets sold in the State of the overall odds of winning a prize for each game.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with printing the odds of winning on all lottery tickets can be absorbed by the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that all lottery tickets must include the overall odds of winning a prize.
