An Act Concerning Public Notice of Lottery Odds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§1, ¶¶K and L, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 505, §2, are amended to read:

K. The manner and amount of compensation to be paid licensed sales agents necessary to provide for the adequate availability of tickets or shares to prospective buyers and for the convenience of the general public; and

L. The apportionment of the total annual revenue accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all 12 other sources for the payment of prizes to the holders of 14 winning tickets or shares; for the payment of costs incurred in the operation and administration of the lotteries, including the expenses of the commission and the costs 16 resulting from any contract or contracts entered into for promotional, advertising, consulting or operational services 18 or for the purchase or lease of lottery equipment and materials; for the repayment of the money appropriated to 20 the State Lottery Fund; and for transfer to the General Fund 22 for distribution pursuant to section 387 -; and

- 24 Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§1, ¶M is enacted to read:
- 26 <u>M. The imprinting on all lottery tickets sold in the State</u> to reflect the odds of winning.

SUMMARY

32 This bill requires the State Lottery Commission to give notice to a person purchasing a lottery ticket in the State of 34 the odds of winning in a game of chance by printing the odds on the face of the lottery ticket.
