Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before 20 the first paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title the following:

24 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
26 as emergencies; and

28 Whereas, it is necessary that this legislation take effect before the summer begins so that retailers may take full 30 advantage of this legislation; and

32 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 34 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 36 safety; now, therefore,''

38 Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

46 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
