Nonsmoking area 6 A licensee may establish a nonsmoking area in a room or outdoor area separate from the area where numbers are called if 8 that room or outdoor area has a master board, a public address system and an employee of the licensee present at all times 10 during a beano or bingo game. 12 **SUMMARY** 14 16 This bill provides that an organization licensed to conduct beano or bingo games may establish a nonsmoking area in a room or outdoor area separate from the area where numbers are called if 18 that room or outdoor area has a master board, a public address 20 system and an employee of the licensee present at all times during a beano or bingo game.
