2. Other tobacco. A tax is imposed on cigars, pipe tobacco and other tobacco intended for smoking at the rate of 13% of the wholesale sales price beginning October 1, 1989; 14% of the wholesale sales price beginning January 1, 1991; and 16% of the wholesale sales price beginning July 1, 1991; and 10% of the wholesale sales price beginning October 1, 1997.

14 SUMMARY

16 Under current law, a tax of 16% is imposed on cigars, pipe tobacco and other tobacco intended for smoking. This bill changes the tax to 10%.
