Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §683 is enacted to read:
§683. Petitioners
3000. I CCLCAOMCID
Within 250 feet of the entrance to a voting place or a
register's office, the town clerk may restrict the circulation of
an initiative or a referendum on election day by restricting the
number and location of the petitioners and by providing
guidelines for conduct of the petitioners.
Any restrictions placed on petitioners must have been
published at least 30 days in advance of the election.
SUMMARY
This bill authorizes town clerks to publish guidelines as to
location, conduct and number of petitioners circulating petitions on election day.
