An Act to Make the University of Maine System Board of Trustees an Elected Body.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, first ¶, first sentence, as amended by PL 1985, c. 779, §89, is further amended to read: 4 6 Section 4. Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System shall--eensist consists of 16 18 8 members. Sec. 2. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1983, c. 10 799, $\S4$, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: 12 2. Members; election. One member must be elected from each of the 16 counties of the State at a statewide general election 14 held in November. Members serve 4-year terms beginning on January 1st of the year following the election. Trustees may 16 serve a maximum of 2 terms, except that a person appointed to fill an unexpired term of 2 years or less is eligible for 18election to 2 full terms. Vacancies must be filled by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of 20 the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters. Trustees serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for 22 travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of their 24 official duties. Sec. 3. Effective date; transition. This Act takes effect January 26 1998. Current members of the Board of Trustees of 1, the 28 University of Maine System serve until January 1, 1999. The Governor may fill vacancies in the manner provided by the

30 university charter on July 1, 1997. The first election of trustees under this Act occurs at the November general election 32 in 1998. Members elected in 1998 assume office on January 1, 1999.
