

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§4, ¶A, as amended by PL 1995, c. 410, §1, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§4, ¶A-1, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 410, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 3. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 595, §3, is repealed.

SUMMARY

The purpose of this bill is to equalize tolls by repealing provisions that allow the Maine Turnpike Authority to authorize commuter discounts and variable surcharges.
