HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 964, L.D. 1327, Bill, "An Act to Regulate Recreational Vehicle Franchises"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substituted title the following:

Further amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, personal sports mobile dealers in this State are currently being subjected to economic coercion by certain manufacturers; and

Whereas, this legislation protects those dealers from such coercion; and

Whereas, it is imperative to address this issue and ensure the ability of such dealers to conduct their business without such coercion; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,


