HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 964, L.D. 1327, Bill, "An Act to Regulate Recreational Vehicle Franchises"

Amend the amendment by inserting before section 1 the following:

Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1171, sub-§11, as amended by PL 1995, c. 65, Pt. A, §14 and affected by §153 and Pt. C, §15, is further amended to read:

11. Motor vehicle. "Motor vehicle" means any motor driven vehicle, except motorcycles, required to be registered under Title 29-A, chapter 5.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§1242.~~" in subsection 15 in the 4th line (page 3, line 45 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "2;" the following: 'any motorcycle as defined in Title 29-A, section 101, subsection 38;'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.


