COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 412, L.D. 1333, "Resolve, Regarding the Posting of Certain Roads by the Department of Transportation"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1997" and inserting in its place the following: '2002'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost to reconstruct and repair approximately 43 miles of Route 11 in Aroostook County is approximately \$16 million. Highway Fund allocations for the 20% state share of this project totaling \$3.2 million will be required. The federal share will be 80% or \$12.8 million. The Department of Transportation has until December 31, 2002 to complete this work.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. It changes from December 31, 1997 to December 31, 2002 the date by which the Department of Transportation must reconstruct or repair portions of Route 11 between the towns of Sherman and Ashland.
