2           **Sec. 1. Reconstruction and repair. Resolved:** That, by December  
31, 1997, the Department of Transportation shall reconstruct or  
4 repair portions of Route 11 between the towns of Sherman and  
Ashland in such a fashion as to reasonably ensure that the  
5 roadway will not face restriction or closure under the terms of  
6 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 2395.

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#### SUMMARY

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12           This resolve requires that the Department of Transportation  
reconstruct or repair portions of Route 11 in Aroostook County  
13 such that that roadway is of a condition adequate to reasonably  
14 ensure that the road will not be "posted" seasonally or otherwise  
restricted due to concerns of safety or roadway damage.
