An Act Relating to Municipal Excise Tax Reimbursement.

(EMERGENCY)

Submitted by the Secretary of State pursuant to Joint Rule 204. Reference to the Committee on Taxation suggested and ordered printed.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is necessary for proper accounting procedures to 6 establish the Municipal Excise Tax Reimbursement Fund immediately; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §533, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 440, §2 and 18 affected by §5, is repealed and the following enacted in its place.

<u>§533. Municipal Excise Tax Reimbursement Fund</u>

 Fund established. There is established within the
Highway Fund the Municipal Excise Tax Reimbursement Fund, referred to in this section as the "fund." The fund is a
nonlapsing account.

28 <u>2. Deposits. Revenue derived pursuant to section 531,</u> <u>subsection 6 must be deposited into the fund by the Secretary of</u> 30 <u>State.</u>

32 **3. Use of fund.** The fund may be used as follows.

34 A. Annually, between July 1st and September 30th, the Secretary of State shall disburse to each municipality a sum equal to the difference in the amount of excise tax that 36 would have been collected using the manufacturer's suggested retail price and the excise tax collected on the actual 38 purchase price of each commercial motor vehicle pursuant to Title 36, section 1482, subsection 1, paragraph C, 40 subparagraph (3). The Secretary of State shall provide supporting documentation to each municipality. The 42 reimbursement must be for the period of July 1st to June 44 30th.

- 46 B. The balance of the fund must be transferred to the Highway Fund.
- C. Revenue received on or after July 1, 1997 must be deposited into the fund.

D. Municipal participation is optional. Any municipality wishing to be reimbursed shall collect and provide to the Secretary of State any information the Secretary of State requires to calculate the reimbursement.

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Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect July 1, 1997.

SUMMARY

12 This bill corrects an oversight in Public Law 1995, chapter 440 by establishing an escrow fund to reimburse municipalities for the difference between excise tax based on the manufacturer's suggested retail price and the actual purchase price for heavy 16 trucks.
