COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 423, L.D. 1344, Bill, "An Act to Create the Mt. Blue Standard Water District"

Amend the bill in section 2 in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Pursuant to" the following: 'Title 35-A,'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by adding a new paragraph at the end to read:

'The district shall continue to supply potable water to all existing customers of the Phillips Water Company, whether they reside within or outside of the territorial limits described in section 1.'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out the 2nd sentence (page 1, lines 38 to 40 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Each trustee must be at least 18 years of age, a resident of the district and reside in a household to which the district's service is provided.'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 44 and 45 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "by the voters in accordance with section 7" and inserting in its place the following: 'by the legal voters in the district'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "terms" the following: 'in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 6410, subsection 1'

2 Further amend the bill in section 7 in the 9th to 11th lines
(page 3, lines 9 to 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
3 ", except that the registrars of voters are not required to
4 prepare or the clerks to post new lists of voters" and inserting
in its place the following: '. The registrars shall make a
5 complete list of all the eligible voters of the proposed district
as described in this Act. The list prepared by the registrars
6 governs the eligibility of a voter. Voters who are residing
7 outside the territorial limits of the proposed district, as
8 described in this Act, are not eligible voters and the registrars
of voters shall exclude those voters from the registrars' list'
