

**An Act to Amend the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992
Regarding Nonresident Employers.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §401, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

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6. Nonresident employers. A nonresident employer whose employees work in the State shall obtain coverage under this Act in the State unless exempt under section 113 or unless the employer would be exempt if located in the State.

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SUMMARY

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This bill clarifies that nonresident employers whose employees are in the State on a regular basis are required to obtain coverage for their employees under the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992.

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
