FISCAL NOTE

The Judicial Department will incur some minor additional 30 costs to convene a task force to develop recommendations to implement a court unification. These costs can be absorbed 32 within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.

34 The additional costs associated with providing drafting assistance to the task force can be absorbed by the Legislature 36 utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and directs the Chief 42 Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court to convene a task force to develop recommendations to implement the unification of the 44 Superior and District Courts. The task force shall report periodically to the Chief Justice and the Chief Justice shall 46 submit an interim report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary matters by March 48 15, 1999 and a final report by December 15, 1999, including any necessary legislation. It also adds a fiscal note.
