This Act takes effect January 1, 1999. 34 **SUMMARY** 36 38 This bill increases mandatory motor vehicle insurance limits for damage to property from \$10,000 to \$25,000, for injury to or 40 death of any one person from \$20,000 to \$50,000 and for one accident resulting in injury to or death of more than one person from \$40,000 to \$100,000. The bill also increases mandatory 42 uninsured and underinsured motor vehicle coverage by the same amounts. The bill takes effect January 1, 1999. 44
