HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 428, L.D. 1376, Bill, "An Act to Improve the State's Democracy by Increasing Access to the Ballot and Other Election Processes"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 7 and 8.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes the sections of the bill that prohibit political parties from using the word "independent" by itself as the name of the party and reserving that word to designate unenrolled voters.
