HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 429, L.D. 1377, "Resolve, to Establish a Maine Mobility Fund Task Force"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 8th indented paragraph after the title (page 2, lines 1 to 8 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 6 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 3, lines 21 and 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Second Regular Session of the 118th Legislature" and inserting in its place the following: 'Joint Standing Committee on Transportation'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the task force may request staffing assistance from the Legislative Council. The task force may also request clerical and computer assistance from the Legislative Council.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that any extension of the task force reporting deadline be approved by the Legislative Council rather than by the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. It also clarifies that staffing assistance may be requested of the Legislative Council.
