SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 429, L.D. 1377, "Resolve, to Establish a Maine Mobility Fund Task Force"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 8th indented paragraph after the title (page 2, lines 1 to 8 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of sections 6 and 7 and inserting in their place the following:

**'Sec. 6. Report of task force. Resolved:** That the task force shall submit a report of its findings, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation by January 1, 1998. If the task force requires an extension, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension; and be it further

**Sec. 7. Meetings. Resolved:** That the task force may meet up to 4 times; and be it further

**Sec. 8. Staff assistance. Resolved:** That the task force may request staffing assistance from the Legislative Council. The task force may also request clerical and computer assistance from the Legislative Council; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 10 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 10. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds  
are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes  
of this resolve.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill.  
General Fund appropriations are reduced by \$1,260 in fiscal year  
1997-98 to \$1,680.
