34	the Feasibility of Creating a Maine Mobility Fund from being

It adds to the task force one member selected by the Maine Motor Transport Association. It also requires the task force report be submitted to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation by January 15, 1998. In addition, it requires that any extension of the task force reporting deadline be approved by the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. The amendment also adds an allocation section and a fiscal note.
