**Sec. 1. Request amendment of Coast and Geodetic Survey.**

**Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Marine Resources shall request the Secretary of the United States Department of Commerce to amend the United States Coast and Geodetic Survey compiled by the Department of Commerce as follows:

1. Correct the name of the location labeled "Watts Point" to "Hilt's Point";

2. Correct the name of the location labeled "Burton Point" to "Hathorne's Point";

3. Correct the name of the location labeled "Bradford Point" to "Gaunt Neck"; and

4. Label the actual "Bradford's Point" in the Town of Friendship, just north of Garrison Island.

**SUMMARY**

This resolve directs the Commissioner of Marine Resources to request the Secretary of the United States Department of Commerce to amend the United States Coast and Geodetic Survey, which is compiled by the Department of Commerce.
