SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 999, L.D. 1391, Bill, "An Act to Reestablish the State Compensation Commission"

Amend the amendment by striking out the 2nd paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 29 to 34 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§2-B.~~" in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by inserting after the headnote the following: 'The commission must issue its first report no later than January 1, 1998.' and by striking out the following: "15th" and inserting in its place the following: '1st' and in the 2nd line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "year" the following: 'thereafter'
