COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 1003, L.D. 1395

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The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the council during any interim between sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If the council requests staffing assistance during a legislative session, the Legislature may require additional General Fund appropriations to contract for staff services.

Maine 8 The Forest Service within the Department of Conservation will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$47,354 in fiscal year 1998-99 10 for one additional Chief Planner position and related operating costs to 12 provide staffing assistance to the Maine Council on Sustainable Silviculture. The General Fund appropriations required to fund 14 these costs in fiscal years 1999-2000 and 2000-01 are estimated to be approximately \$56,000 annually.

The Baxter State Park Authority will incur some minor additional costs to participate in the Maine Council on Sustainable Silviculture. These costs can be absorbed within the authority's existing budgeted resources.'
