14	articles of incorporation to the Secretary of State for filing pursuant to section 404.

20	1. Filing. When the articles of incorporation are delivered for filing by the Secretary of State, the Secretary of

38	This bill requires that a for-profit corporation intending to reorganize as a nonprofit corporation must notify the local officials in any municipality or unorganized territory in which
40	it owns real property at least 30 days before it files articles of incorporation with the Secretary of State for nonprofit status.
