HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1010, L.D. 1402, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Civil Offense of Creating a Police Standoff"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§3801." in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "an inaccessible location" and inserting in place the following: 'a location made inaccessible to law enforcement and others by that person' and in the 3rd line (page 2, line 17 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "and" the following: 'that person'
