HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1011, L.D. 1403, Bill, "An Act to Require Consent of a Legal Guardian for the Provision of Prescription Contraception to a Minor"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Require Notification to a Legal Guardian for the Provision of Prescription Contraception to a Minor under 14 Years of Age'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph by striking out all of the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'person who has not attained 14 years of age without notifying the legal guardian of that person.'

FISCAL NOTE

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

This amendment requires physicians or others legally qualified to provide contraceptive supplies or procedures to
