SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1013, L.D. 1405, Bill, "An Act to License Timber Harvesters and Deter Timber Trespassing"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 5-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "truck" the following: 'or trailer'


Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "§2364-B." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "for sale"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "§2364-B." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 3 in amendment) by striking out the following: "for sale"

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the definition of "hauler" to include a person, company or other entity that owns a trailer on which wood is transported.

This amendment also requires any person transporting wood, not just wood for sale, to comply with the provision of the amendment.
