SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1016, L.D. 1408, Bill, "An Act to Redistrict Knox County and Provide for 5 County Commissioners"

Amend the amendment in section 3 by striking out all of the last indented paragraph (page 2, lines 34 to 37 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'The Knox County commissioners are authorized to expend the funds necessary to implement the referendum. The county commissioners shall cause the preparation of the required ballots.'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment eliminates the cost that would be incurred by the Department of the Secretary of State. The cost to prepare and furnish ballots for the countywide referendum is shifted to Knox County.

SUMMARY

The amendment shifts the cost to prepare and furnish ballots for the countywide referendum from the Secretary of State to Knox County.
