Sec. 1. Department of Education directed to review certain procedures regarding special education. Resolved: That the Department of Education is directed to review the process for determining whether a child is entitled to receive special education services and the process used by the department to investigate a complaint that a school administrative unit is not providing adequate special education services, including how the department brings the school unit into compliance after a finding that the school unit is not providing adequate special education services; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the department shall report its findings, and any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Education by December 1, 1997.

## **SUMMARY**

This resolve directs the Department of Education to review the process for determining whether a child is entitled to receive special education services and the process used by the department to investigate a complaint that a school administrative unit is not providing adequate special education services, including how the department brings the school unit into compliance after a finding of inadequacy. The department is directed to report its findings, and any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Education by December 1, 1997.
