Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2366 is enacted to read: 4 §2366. Permission to proceed 6 Notwithstanding the other provisions of this subchapter, if a motor vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeds the weight 8 permitted under this subchapter, a state police officer may, in addition to issuing a summons and fine, issue a permit for the 10 motor vehicle or combination of vehicles to proceed to its destination without off-loading if the officer determines that 12 the excess weight does not constitute a public hazard. 1416SUMMARY 18 This bill permits a state police officer to issue a permit 20 to an overweight motor vehicle to continue to its destination without off-loading if the officer determines that the excess weight does not constitute a public hazard. 22
