Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 2 summary the following: 4 **'FISCAL NOTE** 6 The Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to develop a 8 policy pertaining to the use of ATV's on certain public lands. 10 These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.' 12 14 SUMMARY 16 This amendment removes the emergency provisions from the bill. It clarifies that the policy established by the Bureau of 18 Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation may limit the use of ATV's. It requires the policy to be in place by June 20 1, 1998 and adds a fiscal note to the bill. It also corrects a cross reference.
