The bill transfers the responsibility for the payment of 50% of the tuition costs for certain apprentices from the Maine Technical College System to the Department of Labor. General Fund resources in the amount of \$180,000 in each of fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99 are deappropriated from the system and appropriated to the Department of Labor.

22 In addition to the amounts transferred above, the Department of Labor will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$356,262 and \$388,305 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, 24 respectively, for the previously unfunded costs of providing 50%26 of the tuition costs for certain apprentices and for the costs of implementing a statewide apprenticeship program. The additional 28 appropriations to implement General Fund а statewide apprenticeship program include the transfer of Personal Services 30 costs for certain positions from Federal Expenditure Fund to the General Fund. This transfer of funding from Federal Expenditure Fund to the General Fund is reflected by deallocations of 32 \$101,027 and \$133,070 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. These Federal Expenditure Fund resources will be 34 available for other purposes within the department subject to approval through future legislative allocation or by financial 36 order.'

SUMMARY

42 This amendment limits the financial impact of the bill by removing those words that could be viewed as requiring the 44 Department of Labor to offer certain educational programs, technical assistance and tuition subsidies. The amendment also 46 replaces the word "trade" with "occupation." The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

The amendment also adds an appropriation and an allocation 50 section to the bill.
