Sec. 1. Compensation authorized. Resolved: That the Governor is authorized and directed, upon receipt of the necessary releases and an appropriate settlement agreement to pay \$300,000 from the Risk Management Fund and \$450,000 from the General Fund to compensate Janice Burns as personal representative of the estate of Wrendy Hayne. The compensation authorized by this resolve is in full satisfaction of any and all claims by the estate of Wrendy Hayne against the State, the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, the Department of Human Services and its employees for the murder of Wrendy Hayne at the Augusta Mental Health Institute. compensation and settlement is not intended to, nor does it, absolve any of the doctors who were employed on a temporary basis through CompHealth or others whom the estate of Wrendy Hayne seeks to hold personally liable.

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## SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Governor to use \$300,000 from the Risk Management Fund and \$450,000 from the General Fund to compensate Janice Burns as personal representative of the estate of Wrendy Hayne who was murdered while residing at the Augusta Mental Health Institute.
