An Act to Clarify Reimbursement by Responsible Parties to the Maine Coastal and Inland Surface Oil Clean-up Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §551, sub-§8 is enacted to read: 4 8. Disbursements to state agencies. A state agency that seeks reimbursement from the Maine Coastal and Inland Surface Oil б Clean-up Fund for costs related to oil spill response activities 8 shall keep time records demonstrating the amount of spill response activities performed for which reimbursement is sought. A state agency may establish a dedicated account for receipt of 10 disbursements from the fund. Disbursements from the fund to a state agency pursuant to subsection 5, paragraph B must be 12 deposited in that account, if it has been established, and may be 14used by the agency to support its activities. 16 SUMMARY 18 This bill authorizes a state agency that has incurred costs related to oil spill response activities to establish an account 20

for receipt of disbursements from the Maine Coastal and Inland Surface Oil Clean-up Fund. The bill requires an agency seeking reimbursement to keep time records demonstrating the amount of spill response activities performed for which reimbursement is sought.

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
