COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1023, L.D. 1440, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Dedimus Justices from Receiving Payment for Services other than Long-distance Travel Reimbursement"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S4-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "50" and inserting in its place the following: '25'

SUMMARY

This amendment, the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government, shortens the distance that a dedimus justice must travel before being allowed to receive reimbursement for mileage expenses.
