2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1354, sub-§1, ¶I** is enacted to read:

6 I. "Public school" means a public school as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 24.

8 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1354, sub-§2-A** is enacted to read:

10 2-A. License condition. An instructor licensed under subsection 2 may not teach driver education to a student in a public school if the instructor teaches that student in any other class offered in that school and the instructor:

14 A. Utilizes the public school for teaching a driver education course without paying the standard fee applicable to use of the school's facilities; or

18 B. Utilizes motor vehicles for driver education that are registered by the public school or the school administrative unit under which the public school is administered.

24 **SUMMARY**

26 This bill prohibits an instructor in a commercial driving school from teaching driver education to a public school student if the instructor also teaches the student in any class at the public school and either utilizes the public school for teaching a driver education course without paying the standard fee applicable to use of the school's facilities or utilizes motor vehicles for driver education that are registered by the public school or the school administrative unit under which the public school is administered.
