An Act to Prohibit the Denial of Teacher Certification Based on Refusal to Participate in Learning Results.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13011, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
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-	8. Learning results. The state board and the commissioner
6	may not refuse to issue or renew a certificate under this chapter
	and may not seek to revoke a certificate issued under this
8	chapter because of an individual's refusal, due to conscientious
	objections, to participate in:

	A. The system of learning results established and
12	implemented under section 6209; or
14	B. Professional development designed to promote learning
	results.
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	<u>The state board shall adopt rules establishing procedures for</u>
18	determining if the individual's refusal relating to paragraph A
	or B is due to conscientious objection. Rules adopted pursuant
20	to this subsection are routine technical rules, pursuant to Title
2.2	<u>5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.</u>
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26	This bill ensures that teacher certification is not
-0	conditioned on participation in the learning results system or
28	related professional development. It permits an individual
	subject to certification to refuse to be involved in learning
30	results due to conscientious objection to the system. The State
	Board of Education is required to establish procedures for
32	determining if the refusal is due to conscientious objection.

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
