

**Sec. 1. Designate the East-West Highway; install signs. Resolved:**

2 That the Department of Transportation shall designate the  
following roads in Maine as the East-West Highway and install  
4 signs indicating these roads as one highway: Route 9 from Calais  
to Bangor, Interstate 95 from Bangor to Newport and Route 2 from  
6 Newport to Rumford to New Hampshire; including its northeast  
corridor, Interstate 95 from Houlton to Route 2 in Newport and  
8 from Route 6 from New Brunswick to Route 2 in Lincoln to  
Interstate 95 in Bangor, and its northwest corridor, from  
10 Skowhegan to Quebec on Route 201 and notify cartographers in  
Maine of this action.
