SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1037, L.D. 1454, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Prevailing Wage Laws"


Amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "**§1308.**" in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 3, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1997" and inserting in its place the following: '1999'

**FISCAL NOTE**

Delaying the date by which the Department of Labor must determine prevailing wages and benefits for the construction industry will result in the delay of costs that will be incurred by the department until September of 1999.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment changes the date by which prevailing wages and benefits must be determined for the construction industry from September 1997 to September 1999.
