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## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 118TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1038, L.D. 1455, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 500: Stormwater Management, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Land and Water Quality".

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and 22 inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Report; legislation. Resolved: That the Commissioner of 24 Environmental Protection, no later than January 15, 1998, shall 26 report to the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources on proposed measures that would reduce the contribution of nonpoint 28 source pollution to Maine lakes, streams and coastal waters from existing sources. In developing these measures, the Department 30 of Environmental Protection shall consult with members of small businesses and a broad cross-section of potentially affected 32 other relevant stakeholders, as well as agencies and The Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources Legislators. may report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 34 118th Legislature regarding application of the storm water 36 management laws statewide and to existing sources.'

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Environmental Protection will incur some minor additional costs to submit a required report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.
