Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 **Sec. 1.** 12 MRSA §7368, sub-§2-A, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
4 571, §3, is amended to read:

6 A. Saturdays: 800 1,000 commercial passengers;

8 **Sec. 2. Allocation of additional whitewater trips.** The additional
9 commercial whitewater rafting trips created in section 1 of this
10 Act are to be allocated by the Department of Inland Fisheries and
11 Wildlife in accordance with the most recent allocation results
12 pursuant to the Maine Revised Statues, Title 12, section 7369.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill increases the commercial whitewater rafting
19 recreational use limits on the Kennebec River on Saturdays from
20 800 commercial passengers to 1,000. The Department of Inland
21 Fisheries and Wildlife is directed to allocate the additional
22 trips in accordance with current law.
