	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7368, sub-§2-A, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
4	571, §3, is amended to read:
6	<pre>A. Saturdays: 800 <u>1,000</u> commercial passengers;</pre>
8	Sec. 2. Allocation of additional whitewater trips. The additional commercial whitewater rafting trips created in section 1 of this
10	Act are to be allocated by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in accordance with the most recent allocation results
12	pursuant to the Maine Revised Statues, Title 12, section 7369.

16	SUMMARY
18	This bill increases the commercial whitewater rafting recreational use limits on the Kennebec River on Saturdays from
20	800 commercial passengers to 1,000. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is directed to allocate the additional
22	trips in accordance with current law.
