## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1361, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 195, 4 §1, is amended to read:

8. Goods. "Goods" means residential, recreational, agricultural, farm, forestry, construction, utility, commercial
or business equipment, machinery or appliances that use electricity, gas, wood, a petroleum product or a derivative of a petroleum product, for operation. "Goods" does not include motor vehicles as defined in section 1171, subsection 11.
