

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1361, sub-§8**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 195,
4 §1, is amended to read:

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7 **8. Goods.** "Goods" means residential, recreational,
8 agricultural, farm, forestry, construction, utility, commercial
9 or business equipment, machinery or appliances that use
10 electricity, gas, wood, a petroleum product or a derivative of a
11 petroleum product, for operation. "Goods" does not include motor
12 vehicles as defined in section 1171, subsection 11.

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SUMMARY

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17 This bill adds dealers in forestry, construction or utility
18 goods to the franchise laws for power equipment, machinery and
19 appliances.

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
