	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §952, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 694,
4 .	Pt. B, §2 and affected by Pt. E, §2, is amended to read:
6	4. Enforcement. The court may enforce an order as provided under chapter 65. The court may enforce an order of support in
8	the manner provided in chapter 65, subchapter II, article 2 and has all of the rights and duties of the department under that
1,0	article. For the purposes of enforcement of an order of support under chapter 65, subchapter II, article 2, an order of support
12	under this subchapter has the same status as an order of support under that article.
14	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 1997.
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18	SUMMARY
20	This bill provides that a person who is in default on a spousal support order is subject to the same enforcement
22	provisions that apply to default on child support obligations regarding professional license revocation. Enforcement would be

pursued by the court issuing the order rather than the Department

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of Human Services.
