10	'FISCAL NOTE
12	The Bureau of Insurance within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor
14	additional costs to approve certain forms pertaining to health insurance policies. These costs can be absorbed within the
16	bureau's existing budgeted resources.
18	This bill may increase the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative
20	costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
22	Department. The collection of additional filing fees may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

26	SUMMARY
28	This amendment removes the rebuttable presumption language in the bill. It requires the Superintendent of Insurance to
30	initiate enforcement proceedings when investigation of the circumstances surrounding the procurement of an individual policy
32	at the time of replacement of group coverage produces evidence of a violation of the antidumping provisions in the bill.

36	The amendment also removes sections of the bill that conflict with provisions contained in the Committee Amendment to

with Federal Laws." It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
